

2016 Brentwood Environmental Stewardship Awards

The Brentwood Mayor and City Council and the Environmental Advisory Board (EAB) invite you to submit a nomination, which may be a self-nomination, for the Environmental Stewardship Awards Program. These awards allow the City to recognize and show appreciation for those who give back to the community to improve or conserve the environment and to encourage others to get involved.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any Brentwood citizen; business, school, or organization based within the Brentwood city limits; or any non-Brentwood resident or organization whose work impacts the City's environment. Award nominations may include any manner of project (including construction) or program that serves to enhance the environment, protect or conserve natural resources, or promotes volunteerism that serves environmental causes. Nominations may also include individuals who go above and beyond as a community volunteer serving or promoting the environment.



Projects or programs conducted or completed within the last five (5) years are eligible.

DEADLINE: Nominations must be submitted by 2:00 p.m. on Friday, March 11, 2016.

JUDGING: The Brentwood Environmental Advisory Board will select a panel of environmental professionals to evaluate the applications based upon the program or person's effectiveness, innovation, and lasting impact upon the City's environment.

AWARD PRESENTATION: Awards will be presented at the Brentwood Arbor Day Ceremony on April 2, 2016.
