**VALLEY VIEW FARM**

Valley View Farm was the home of the late Mary Sneed Jones, prominent local historian and civic leader. She was a descendant of Brentwood pioneer James Sneed, a Revolutionary War soldier. The land adjoins the original Sneed grant. The house, built of native woods in 1880, still features the original poplar siding and shutters. The house was built by the Tom Oden heirs and was bought by the Sneed-Jones family in 1901. The first toll house on Wilson Pike (then called the Harpeth Turnpike) was across the road from the house. They were spaced at two mile intervals along the road. The original Brentwood post office building stands in the yard.
