

Foxview was built by Alexander Ewing Sneed, youngest child of pioneer James Sneed. He had two sons who served in the Confederate Army. Foxview was bought by the Shwab family, who extensively rebuilt and remodeled, using the old house as the central core of the building.

Foxview was built by Alexander Ewing Sneed the youngest son of James Sneed. This antebellum home was built in 1835. It is a two story Greek Revival style house with pillars.

Like some of his brothers, Alexander got his land from his father near the old homestead. Alexander married Elizabeth Guthrie. They had twelve children, two of whom were confederate soldiers.

The Sneed name has been represented in every war America has been in.

Today Foxview is owned by Mrs. George Shwab, Jr. They bought it in about 1950. Greatly preserved, it is one of the most beautiful houses in the area.
