

Downloading and Streaming Music with Freegal

*** Instructions for app-based devices (e.g. Android phones/tablets, iPhones/iPads).**

You will need:

- A valid John P. Holt Brentwood library card
- Access to wi-fi for your device
- Logged in to your Freegal service (see below)
- The Freegal app downloaded to your device (see below)

Initial App/Account Setup

1. Open your device's store app and search, "freegal music".
2. Select the app with a logo matching the image above.
3. When the app finishes downloading, open it.
4. Enter the library's zip code (i.e. 37027), and tap Continue.
5. Select "Brentwood Library" at the next prompt.
6. Enter in your library card number (The long number under the barcode) in the provided field.
7. Enter your Pin in the provided field. Your Pin is usually the last four digits of your phone number associated with your library account.

Searching for Songs

There are a couple of ways to go about discovering new songs/albums/artists or looking for a specific song or artist.

- On the bottom bar of the app, you will see four icons. Tap "Browse" to see what is currently the most popular on Freegal.
- On the bottom bar of the app, you will see four icons. Tap "Search" to begin looking for specific content.

Downloading or Streaming Music

- Upon locating a song you want to download, tap the vertical three dots on the right side.
- To see what music you have downloaded or added to a streaming playlist, tap "My Music" on the bottom bar of the app
