## PATHS & TRAILS RULES

- Alcohol, Fireworks, Weapons and Hunting are prohibited
- Fishing is prohibited unless otherwise posted
- Everyone must ride/skate/walk to the right and yield to oncoming traffic
- Cyclists must dismount bicycles in all posted dismount zones
- Pets must be on a short leash and controlled at all times
- Pet owners are responsible for removing pet waste. Please use the provided pet waste removal stations with bags
- Horses, ponies, or any farm animals, are prohibited
- Removal of any wildlife or vegetation from the park is prohibited except for pre-approved school projects.
- Motorized vehicles are not permitted on paths, trails or grass without permission from parks department.
- Non-Profit fundraising events in parks requires special permit from the Parks & Recreation Dept and Park Board. (Five (5) special events are allowed each year)
- Paths and trails are closed to the public from sunset until daylight or 6:00 a.m., whichever time is earlier, unless posted otherwise
- Vandalism or damage to property will not be tolerated. Violators will be prosecuted
- All other general park rules and regulations also remain in force
